Institute News



Third Batch Joins: Orientation Programme

The Institute admitted its third batch of 128 students (112 boys and 16 girls) on July 22, 2010. An orientation programme for the new students was held during July 22-27, 2010 for their smooth transition from school and home atmosphere to the IIT campus. The chief guest, Dr A L Ravimohan, a former Vice President of Technology, Castrol International, Mumbai, India in his inaugural address inspired the students to be 'Creative Scientist Engineers' and to take leadership roles. Dr Ravimohan is a President's Gold Medal winning BTech (1967) from IIT Bombay and PhD (1971) from California Institute of Technology, USA. Director Sudhir K Jain, emphasized hard work as the key to success for the students.

A number of workshops formed the majority of Orientation process. These included Sailing Through IIT by Ms Madhu Chadda, aimed at stress management, time management, creativity and development of IIT culture, Celebrating the Unique ME by Ms Jasbir Thadhani, Counseling Psychologist of IIT Gandhinagar on discovering own uniqueness, What is it like to be an IITian: Facts and Fictions by Prof Jayant Kanitkar, and Personality Development by Ms Rashmi Datt, to develop teamwork, interpersonal communication skills and crisis management. The students were also exposed to the Cultural and Architectural Heritage of Ahmedabad by Theater and Media Centre, Ahmedabad. The parents and the



Institute faculty discussed how parents could be part of IITGN's vision and mission. As a part of the Orientation programme, three faculty members and the Institute Counseling Psychologist talked to all the students on one-to-one basis to understand their backgrounds, goals, hopes, aspirations, and concerns. The exercise was aimed at preparing the new students share their issues, academic or personal, if and when needed, with any faculty member without any hesitation. It also helps the Institute to discover and develop the talents of students.

Second Meeting of the Board of Governors

Second meeting of the Board of Governors was held on September 21, 2010. Besides routine matters, the Board considered and approved important proposals helping push excellence in the Institute. These proposals included: a document Vision of the Institute; the document Partnerships in Pursuit of Excellence: Fund Raising Strategy that outlines action plan for raising money and seeking active partners who share our vision and are willing to help; Student Participation in Academic Senate of the Institute and the Senate Committees; Merit Scholarships for Students based only on their performance in Academics, Sports & Games, Arts/Culture, or Social Works & Leadership; and Excellence Awards to Faculty Members for outstanding contributions in the fields of Teaching, Research, Institution Building and Outreach.

Activities at IITGN

IIT Gandhinagar Vision



A Vision Retreat was organized to evolve IIT Gandhinagar's Mission, Vision, Values, and Principles with a view to make it a great place to live and work, and to make it a preferred destination for future generations of students, staff and faculty. A select group of faculty, students, non-teaching staff, invited guests and the Director discussed and debated the related issues on August 27 and 28, 2010 at a prominent hotel in Ahmedabad. Prof Jayant Kanitkar, primary motivator of the event, led the discussions. A draft document thus prepared was later shared with the entire Institute community for comments and suggestions. The final document was then presented to the Board of Governors for consideration.

Non Degree Students at IITGN

With a view to enrich the learning environment through diversity of the student body, IITGN will admit, through a rigorous process, a limited number of undergraduate and postgraduate students to pursue course work or research for one or two semesters. This work can count towards the degree requirements at the student's own Institute or University within India or abroad but not at IITGN. Mr Ashutosh Singla from L N Mittal Institute of Information Technology, Jaipur is the first to join the Institute under this provision in July 2010 for one semester.



Inauguration of a New Building

A newly built 1000 sq.m building was formally inaugurated on July 15, 2010 by Prof Vedanth Kadambi, the senior most Visiting Professor of the Institute in the presence of faculty, staff and students of IITGN and VGEC and CPWD officials. It has been built by IITGN on the VGEC campus through the Central PWD in a record time; a total of seven months from preliminary proposal from CPWD (December 18, 2009) to the inauguration (July 15, 2010). The building houses Mechanical Engineering and Physics laboratories, offices of the faculty, research scholars and their research facility.



Earn While You Learn Programme

The Institute encourages undergraduate students with good academic performance to undertake academic responsibilities like grading home work, helping users of Computer Centre, assisting Institute faculty in book writing, and providing help in the Library. The selected students are permitted to devote upto 10 hours per week on this activity, and are paid an honorarium for their time so that it is truly an "Earn While You Learn" Programme. A total of 22 students were selected to participate in this programme for the first semester of 2010-11.

Short Credit Courses for Students

The Institute has a provision of "Short Courses for Credit" for the undergraduate students. A minimum of 8 one hour lectures are delivered by either an IITGN faculty or a visitor for a one credit course. The following courses were conducted during this quarter:

- Making of a Professional Engineer: Professional Ethics & Tools for Thinking by Prof Raj Chhabra, Department of Chemical Engineering, IIT Kanpur on August 7, 2010. One hundred fifty students registered for the course.
- Entrepreneurship Opportunities for Engineers by Arvind K Singhal, Chairman, Technopak Advisors Pvt. Ltd, Gurgaon on August 21-22, 2010. Eighty students registered for the course.
- Cosmology The Story of Our Universe by Dr Raghavan Rangarajan, Physical Research Laboratory, Ahmedabad from August 24 - September 7, 2010. Thirty five students registered for the course.

New Research Scholars

Eight new PhD scholars have been admitted to the Institute during the first semester of 2010-11 in the Departments of Electrical Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, Chemical Engineering, Cognitive Sciences and Physics. They have freedom to choose their thesis supervisor and pursue research in the area of their interest. Their collaborative research brings greater visibility to the supervisor and the Institute through research publications.

Women's Cell Constituted

A Women's Cell has been constituted at the Institute with Prof Joycee Mekie as the Convener and seven members drawn from faculty, staff and students. The primary purpose of the Cell is to help the Institute protect people against sexual harassment and to maintain/protect their dignity. The Institute's Women's Cell is committed to serving everyone living or working on the campus without a gender bias. This cell is also being called CARE (Cell And Resource for Everyone).
